The meeting was called to order by President, Eileen Patton at 9:00pm.

I. Questions, Concerns, Comments

- a. There were no comments voiced.

II. Kickball Update

- a. Thanks to everyone who helped, participated, and paid! Congrats to our winning team, Baseball!
- b. Teams that did not pay include, Men's Tennis, Men's Golf, Men's Basketball, Football; all teams that haven't paid with the exception of Football are required to collect \$2 per athlete; football will need to collect \$1 per player
- c. We have made about \$280 without the money from these teams.

III. Next Fundraiser – Parents Night Out – Make-A-Wish

- a. Friday, Dec. 8th from 6-10pm
- b. SAAC reps agreed that donations only will be given to SAAC; if anyone tries to drop off children without paying, we will expect them to pay a minimum amount, such as \$20.
- c. Ages 5-12, faculty/staff children; others may come if there is a connection with a SAAC rep.
- d. Activities that will be available:
 - i. Crafts in Classroom 2 (making gifts for parents)
 - ii. Games in Ruth Lilly Gym
 - iii. Cartoon Christmas Movie in Multi-Purpose Room
- d. We need a committee
 - i. A sheet was passed around for SAAC members to sign up and list their preferred activity; if other reps or athletes would like to be on the Parents Night Out Committee, email Eileen.
 - ii. Flyers will need to be created and promoted to faculty and staff to make Christmas shopping a little more convenient.
- e. We need Help!
 - i. A sheet was passed around to sign up for helping; all SAAC reps will be required to help.
 - ii. SAAC reps should tell their teams about coming to help.
 - iii. Kids will be separated by age groups and about 1 person per 2-3 kids is needed.

- iv. If we make a sufficient sum from this, we will not have to do another fundraiser for Make-A-Wish and will not have to ask people for money.
- f. A liability waiver will need to be created.

V. Evaluation and Update of the Evaluation Tool
