2007 SEASON REVIEW

The 2007 season saw the Greyhounds go 11-6-5 and advancing to the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) Semi-Finals for the first time since 1999 with a penalty kick win against Southern Illinois University-Edwardsville. During this season the Greyhounds broke into the NSCAA Top 25 national rankings (for the third season in a row) and finished fifth in the NCAA Regional Rankings, one spot out of a NCAA Tournament berth.

KEY STADIUM

The camp will be conducted on the same grounds where the UIndy soccer teams train and play matches. Among these facilities is Key Stadium, an exciting game environment that seats up to 4,000 and features a recently resurfaced field turf playing field.

CAMP DIRECTOR



UIndy Head Coach John Griffin, the winningest coach in the program's history, just finished his fourth season at the helm of the UIndy Men's Soccer team. During this time, Griffin has accumulated a record of 43-25-10, leading the Greyhounds to the GLVC tournament three of his four seasons. In 2004 Griffin was named GLVC Men's Soccer Coach of the Year. Coach Griffin has an impressive résumé in youth soccer as well, having served as director of coaching for Dynamo FC out of Indianapolis. He serves on the Region II ODP staff as an assistant to the 1991 team that will be competing in Austria. Coach Griffin has been influential in the development of countless collegiate players and some who have gone on to careers in professional soccer. A USSF "A" licensed coach, Griffin also holds his NSCAA Premier diploma and the USSF National Youth license.

ASSISTANT DIRECTOR

UIndy Assistant Coach Gabe Hall brings a wealth of playing and coaching experience to the Greyhound Campers. The spring of 2008 marks the start of Coach Hall's second year on staff with the UIndy men's soccer program. He is responsible for training the Greyhound goalkeepers along with assisting with team training. Coach Hall works with a boys' youth team in the Carmel United Soccer Club and is part of the Indiana ODP staff.

CAMP OVERVIEW

The UIndy Men's Soccer Coaching staff has designed the Soccer Camp curriculum to comprehensively address all major aspects of the game in a challenging and fun environment. Morning sessions will focus on the technical skills such as moves, dribbling, passing, receiving the ball, shooting, and defending. At the end of the morning session, we will have a skills competition involving the technical topic of the day. The afternoon session will address the tactical side of soccer, concentrating on possession, speed of play, combination play, attacking shape, and team defending. At the end of each day, campers will play games that allow them to put to use the knowledge they've attained. On the last day of camp, awards will be handed out to the campers that win the different skills competitions.
